Rules and Guidelines

- Cake creation is to be made only by the Scout and the male father figure in his life (father, grandfather, uncle, brother, cousin, coach, male neighbor, etc.).
- The Scout team needs to design, create and bake a cake without the help of mom or any female counterpart *if at all possible*. Don't forget...Mom is not responsible for cleaning up the kitchen when you are done, so make sure you include clean up in your plans.
- The entire cake (*all ingredients*) must be edible! Use carrots, pretzels, broccoli etc., for decorations.
- There is no limit on size or shape of cake or quantity of edible ingredients.
- A cake mix is acceptable, but store bought pre-made cakes (*i.e. Publix bakery*) are not permitted.
- Please consider using a disposable (but recyclable) plate or display platform.
- Check-in will begin @ 5:00p.m. The banquet will begin at 6:00 p.m.
- **Name your cake.** Your cake needs a descriptive name or title, **but do not put your name** on the cake. At check in you'll be assigned a number for your cake.
- The judges' decisions are final.

Please remember that your cake will be used for our dessert.
